Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone I —

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most-pure body, Thou didst rise on the third day, O Saviour, granting life to the world; the powers of heaven, therefore, cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: "Glory to Thy resurrection, O Christ: glory to Thy kingdom: glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who lovest mankind."

Troparion, Tone IV —

Thy holy martyr Artemius, O Lord, through his sufferings, hath received an incorruptible crown from Thee, our God: for, having Thy strength, he laid low his adversaries, and shattered the powerless boldness of demons; through his intercessions, save our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone II —

Let us gather to sing worthy hymns in honour of Artemius, the pious and victorious martyr who defeated his enemies; he is great among martyrs, and generous in performing miracles; and he intercedeth with the Lord on behalf of us all.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone I —

As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself; human nature praiseth Thee as God; for death hath vanished: Adam exulteth, O Master; Eve rejoiceth; for she is freed from bondage, and crieth to Thee: "Thou art the giver of resurrection to all, O Christ."

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 1: Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us as we have set our hope on Thee!

Verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O ye righteous! Praise befits the just!

pistle: (2 Corinthians 9:6-11) Brethren, he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. ⁷ So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudg-

ingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. ⁸ And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may have an abundance for every good work. ⁹ As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." ¹⁰ Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have *sown* and increase the fruits of your righteousness, ¹¹ while *you are* enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

Alleluia Verses:

God gives vengeance unto me, and subdues people under me.

He magnifies the salvation of the King and deals mercifully with David, His anointed, and his seed forever.

Gospel: (Luke 16:19-31) Jesus told this parable: 19 "There was a certain rich man who was clothed in purple and fine linen and fared sumptuously every day. ²⁰ But there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, full of sores, who was laid at his gate, ²¹ desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table. Moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. ²² So it was that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died and was buried. 23 And being in torments in Hades, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. ²⁴ "Then he cried and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.' 25 But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted and you are tormented. ²⁶ And besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed, so that those who want to pass from here to you cannot, nor can those from there pass to us.' 27 "Then he said, 'I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father's house, ²⁸ for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.' 29 Abraham said to him, 'They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.' 30 And he said, 'No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.' ³¹ But he said to him, 'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.'


