Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone IV —

When the women disciples of the Lord learnt, from the angel, the joyous message of Thy resurrection, they cast away the ancestral curse, and elatedly told the apostles: "Death is overthrown; Christ God is risen, granting the world great mercy."

Troparion, Tone IV —

The river Jordan was turned back by the mantle of Elisha, after Elijah had been taken up to heaven; the waters were parted in two; and the stream became a dry path; this was truly a type of baptism, by which, we pass over the stream of life: Christ hath shone forth in the Jordan to sanctify the waters.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone IV —

My Saviour and Redeemer, as God, rose from the tomb, and delivered the earth-born from their chains; He hath shattered the gates of hell; and, as Master, He hath risen on the third day.

O Christ, in Thy compassion and infinite mercy, Thou art coming, as a man, to be baptized in the Jordan, in order to take away the many transgressions of us all, clothing me in the garment of ancient glory, of which, I was cruelly stripped bare.

Today, the Lord entereth the Jordan, and crieth out to John: "Be not afraid to baptize me: for I have come to save Adam, the first-formed man."

"John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. ⁵ Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to him and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins. ⁶ Now John was clothed with camel's hair and with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. ⁷ And he preached, saying, "There comes One after me who is mightier than I, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to stoop down and loose. ⁸ I indeed baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."


