Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone V —

Let us, the faithful, praise and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, born, for our salvation, from the Virgin: for He willed to be lifted up on the Cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead by His glorious resurrection.

Troparion, Tone I —

When Thou, O Lord, wast baptized in the Jordan, the worship of the Trinity was made manifest: for the voice of the Father bare witness to Thee, and called Thee His beloved Son; and the Spirit, in the form of a dove, confirmed the truthfulness of His word. O Christ our God, Who hast revealed Thyself, and hast enlightened the world, glory to Thee.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone V —

Thou didst descend into hell, O my Saviour, shattering its gates, as almighty, resurrecting the dead, as creator, and destroying the sting of death; Thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Man; and we cry to Thee: "O Lord, save us."

Today, Thou hast appeared to the universe; and Thy light, O Lord, hath shone on us, who, with understanding, praise Thee: Thou hast come, and revealed Thyself, O light unapproachable.

pistle: (Ephesians 4:7-13) Brethren, to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. ⁸ Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men." ⁹ (Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? ¹⁰ He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) ¹¹ And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, ¹² for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, ¹³ till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;

From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."
