Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone II — When Thou didst descend to death, O Life Immortal, Thou didst slay hell with the splendour of Thy Godhead; and when, from the depths, Thou didst raise the dead, all the powers of heaven cried out: "O Giver of Life, Christ our God, glory to Thee."

Troparion, Tone VIII — As the bountiful harvest of Thy sowing of salvation, the Isles of the Sea offer to Thee, O Lord, all the saints who have shone in them; by their prayers, keep the Church and the Isles in abiding peace, through the Theotokos, O most-merciful One.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone III — Today, the choir of saints who were pleasing to God in the Isles of Britain and Ireland now stands before us in the Church, and invisibly prays to God for us; with them, the angels glorify Him; and all the saints of the Church of Christ keep festival with them; and, together, they all pray for us to the pre-eternal God.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone II — Hell became afraid, O almighty Saviour, seeing the miracle of Thy resurrection from the tomb; the dead arose: creation, with Adam, beheld this, and rejoiced with Thee; and the world, O my Saviour, praiseth Thee forever.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 2: The Lord is my strength and my song; / He has become my salvation (*Resurrection*)

Verse: The Lord has chastened me sorely, but He has not given me over to death.

Pistle: (Romans 5:1-10) Brethren, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. ³ And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; ⁴ and perseverance, character; and character, hope. ⁵ Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who

was given to us. ⁶ For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷ For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. ⁸ But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹ Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. ¹⁰ For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Alleluia Verses:

May the Lord hear thee in the day of trouble! May the name of the God of Jacob protect thee!

Save the King, O Lord, and hear us on the day we call!

Gospel: (Matthew 6:22-33) At that time Jesus said, 22 "The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light. ²³ But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness! ²⁴ "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loval to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. ²⁵ "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? ²⁶ Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? ²⁷ Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature? ²⁸ "So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; ²⁹ and yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. 30 Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? 31 "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' 32 For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. ³³ But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
