Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone V —

Let us, the faithful, praise, and worship, the Word, co-eternal with the Father, and the Spirit, born, for our salvation, from the Virgin: for He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead, by His glorious resurrection.

Troparion, Tone IV —

Thou hast revealed the beauty of the holy dwelling-place of Thy glory on earth to be like the splendour of the heavenly firmament, O Lord; through the prayers of the Theotokos, strengthen it for ever and ever; and accept our supplication, which we, ceaselessly, offer Thee therein, O life and resurrection of all.

Troparion, Tone IV —

We offer, in supplication, the life-creating cross of Thy goodness, O Lord, which Thou hast granted unto us, although we be unworthy; through the Theotokos, save all Orthodox Christians, O only lover of man.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone V —

Thou didst descend into hell, O my Saviour, shattering its gates, as almighty, resurrecting the dead, as Creator, and destroying the sting of death; Thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O lover of man; and we cry unto Thee: 'O Lord, save us'.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion, Tone IV —

The Church hath been revealed to be a heaven filled with light, which enlighteneth all the faithful; standing within it, we cry: 'Establish this house, O Lord'.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 6: O Lord, save Thy people, / and bless Thine inheritance! (Sunday Before)

Verse: To Thee, O Lord, will I call. O my God, be not silent to me!

Tone 4: Holiness befits Thy house, O Lord, / forevermore. (Founding)

pistle: (Galatians 6:11-18) Brethren, ¹¹ See with what large letters I have written to you with my own hand! ¹² As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, only that they may not suffer persecution for the cross of Christ. ¹³ For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh. ¹⁴ But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. ¹⁵ For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation. ¹⁶ And as many as walk according to this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. ¹⁷ From now on let no one trouble me, for I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus. ¹⁸ Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.



Special Parish Meeting: TODAY immediately following Divine Liturgy to ask parish approval for construction of a **handicap accessible bathroom** in the vestibule of the church. The parish council is seeking approval of **\$28,000** which would be funded by re-prioritizing the 2020 capital improvement budget. **NOTE**: We will also be streaming the meeting, as well as offering remote voting options for those unable to be physically present.


