Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the resurrection, Tone I —

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most-pure body, Thou didst rise on the third-day, O Saviour, granting life to the world; the powers-of-heaven, therefore, cried to Thee, O giver-of-life: 'Glory to Thy resurrection, O Christ; glory to Thy kingdom; glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou that lovest mankind'.

Troparion, Tone VIII —

O Gregory the wonder-worker, light of Orthodoxy, support and teacher of the Church, glory of monks, and invincible protector of theologians, pride of Thessalonica, and preacher of grace, pray, without ceasing, for the salvation of our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone VIII —

Holy and divine instrument of wisdom, joyful trumpet of theology, with one accord, we sing thy praises, O Gregory inspired by God: but, since thou standest, now, in mind and spirit, before the original mind, guide our minds to Him, O father, that we may cry to thee: 'Hail, preacher of grace'.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion, Tone IV —

The season of the virtues, now, hath come; and the judge is at the door; let us not hold back with darkened face; but let us keep the fast, offering tears, contrition, and almsgiving; and let us cry: 'Our sins are more in number than the sand of the sea; but, deliverer of all, forgive each one of us, that we may receive an incorruptible crown'.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 5: Thou, O Lord, shalt protect us / and preserve us from this generation forever.

v. Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer any that is godly!

Tone 1: My mouth shall speak wisdom; / the meditation of my heart shall be understanding. (St. Gregory Palamas)

Pistle: (Hebrews 1:10-2:3) Brethren, it is written "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands. ¹¹ They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment; ¹² Like a cloak You will fold them up, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will not fail." ¹³ But to which of the angels has He ever said: "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"? ¹⁴ Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation? ² Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away. ² For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, ³ how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard *Him*,

Alleluia Verses:

God gives vengeance unto me, and subdues people under me.

He magnifies the salvation of the King and deals mercifully with David, His anointed, and his seed forever.

The mouth of the righteous shall meditate wisdom, and his tongue shall speak of judgment.

Gospel: (Mark 2:1-12) At that time, Jesus entered Capernaum after some days, and it was heard that He was in the house. ²Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. ³Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four men. ⁴ And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. ⁵ When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you." ⁶ And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, 7 "Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?" ⁸But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, "Why do you reason about these things in your hearts? ⁹ Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise, take up your bed and walk'? 10 But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—He said to the paralytic, 11 "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." ¹² Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"
