Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone V -

Let us, the faithful, praise, and worship, the Word, co-eternal with the Father, and the Spirit, born, for our salvation, from the Virgin: for He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead, by His glorious resurrection.

Troparion, Tone II —

Righteous passion-bearers, and true fulfillers of the Gospel of Christ, chaste Boris and guileless Gleb, ye resisted not the attacks of your brother, the enemy, when he killed your bodies, but could not touch your souls; wherefore, let the evil lover of power mourn, whilst ye rejoice with the angels, standing before the Holy Trinity; pray that they that honour your memory may be pleasing to God, and that all Orthodox Christians may be saved.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone III —

Today, your most-glorious memory shineth forth, noble participants in the passion of Christ, holy Boris and Gleb; for ye call us together to sing praises to Christ our God; praying to Him before your sacred images, we receive the gift of healing by your prayers: for ye are, indeed, divine healers.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone V -

Thou didst descend into hell, O my Saviour, shattering its gates, as almighty, resurrecting the dead, as Creator, and destroying the sting of death; Thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O lover of man; and we cry unto Thee: 'O Lord, save us'.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 5: Thou, O Lord, shalt protect us / and preserve us from this generation forever. *(Resurrection)*

Verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer any that is godly!

Tone 4: The Lord has shown the wonders of His will / to the saints who are in His land. *(SS. Boris & Gleb)*

Tpistle: (Romans 12:6-14) Brethren, having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; ⁷ or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; ⁸ he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness. ⁹Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good. ¹⁰Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; ¹¹ not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; ¹² rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; ¹³ distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality. ¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.

Gospel: (Matthew 9:1-8) At that time, Jesus got into a boat, crossed over, and came to His own city. ²Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you." ³And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes!" ⁴ But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? ⁵For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise and walk'? ⁶ But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—then He said to the paralytic, "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." ⁷And he arose and departed to his house. ⁸ Now when the multitudes saw *it*, they marveled and glorified God, who had given such power to men.
