Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VI —

The angelic powers were at Thy tomb; the guards became as dead men: Mary stood by Thy grave, seeking Thy most-pure body; Thou didst capture hell, not being tempted by it: Thou didst come to the Virgin, granting life; O Lord, Who didst rise from the dead, glory to Thee.

Troparion, Tone I —

O Lord, save Thy people, and bless Thine inheritance; grant victories to the Orthodox Christians over their adversaries; and, by virtue of Thy Cross, preserve Thy habitation.

Troparion, Tone IV —

He that called thee, from earth to the mansions of heaven, keepeth, also, thy body unharmed after death, O holy Eudocimus: for thou hast lived in chastity, and a pure life, O blessed one, and hast not defiled thy flesh; wherefore, with boldness, pray to Christ God, for our salvation.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone II —

Desiring higher things, and uniting thyself with them on high, thou hast made thy soul a fiery chariot, by the divine ascents of the virtues, O most-blessed Eudocimus; and, living on the earth like one of the incorporeal ones, thou hast been well-pleasing to the Creator of all.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VI —

When Christ God, the giver of life, raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His mighty hand, He bestowed resurrection on the human race: He is the Saviour of all, the resurrection, the life, and the God of all.

Tone 6: O Lord, save Thy people, / and bless Thine inheritance!
(Resurrection)

Verse: To Thee, O Lord, will I call. O my God, be not silent to me!

Epistle: (Romans 15:1-7) Brethren, we who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves. ² Let each of us please *his* neighbor for *his* good, leading to edification. ³ For even Christ did not please Himself; but as it is written, "The reproaches of those who reproached You fell on Me." ⁴ For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope. ⁵ Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, ⁶ that you may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁷ Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.

Alleluia Verses:

He will say to the Lord: "My Protector and my Refuge; my God, in Whom I trust."

Gospel: (Matthew 9:27-35) At that time, when Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, "Son of David, have mercy on us!" ²⁸ And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord." ²⁹ Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith let it be to you." ³⁰ And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly warned them, saying, "See *that* no one knows *it*." ³¹ But when they had departed, they spread the news about Him in all that country. ³² As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed. ³³ And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes marveled, saying, "It was never seen like this in Israel!" ³⁴ But the Pharisees said, "He casts out demons by the ruler of the demons." ³⁵ Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.
