Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone I —

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most-pure body, Thou didst rise, on the third day, O Saviour, granting life to the world; the powers of heaven, therefore, cried to Thee, O giver of life: 'Glory to Thy resurrection, O Christ: glory to Thy kingdom: glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou that lovest mankind'.

Troparion, Tone I —

In giving birth, thou didst preserve thy virginity; in falling asleep, thou didst not forsake the world, O Theotokos; thou wast translated to life, O mother of life: and, by thy prayers, thou deliverest our souls from death.

Troparion, Tone III —

O holy apostle Thaddeus, * pray ye unto the merciful God, * that remission of exceeding sins ** may be granted unto our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone I —

As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself; human nature praiseth Thee as God; for death hath vanished: Adam exulteth, O Master; Eve rejoiceth; for she is freed from bondage, and crieth to Thee: 'Thou art the giver of resurrection to all, O Christ'.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion, Tone II —

The grave and death could not hold the Theotokos, who is sleepless in her intercessions, and an unfailing hope in her mediations: for, as the mother of life, she was translated unto life by Him that dwelt in her ever-virgin womb.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 1: Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee! (*Resurrection*)

Verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just!

Tone 3: My soul doth magnify the Lord, / and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior. (Song of the Theotokos)

Times Pistle: (1 Corinthians 4:9-16) Brethren, I think that God has displayed us, the apostles, last, as men condemned to death; for we have been made a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men. ¹⁰ We are fools for Christ's sake, but you are wise in Christ! We are weak, but you are strong! You are distinguished, but we are dishonored! ¹¹ To the present hour we both hunger and thirst, and we are poorly clothed, and beaten, and homeless. ¹² And we labor, working with our own hands. Being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we endure; ¹³ being defamed, we entreat. We have been made as the filth of the world, the offscouring of all things until now. ¹⁴ I do not write these things to shame you, but as my beloved children I warn you. ¹⁵ For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet you do not have many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. ¹⁶ Therefore I urge you, imitate me.

Alleluia Verses:

God gives vengeance unto me, and subdues people under me.

He magnifies the salvation of the King and deals mercifully with David, His anointed, and his seed forever.

Arise, O Lord, into Thy rest, Thou and the Ark of Thy sanctification!

Gospel: (Matthew 17:14-23) At that time, when Jesus had come to the multitude, a man came to Him, kneeling down to Him and saying, ¹⁵ "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water. ¹⁶ So I brought him to Your disciples, but they could not cure him." ¹⁷ Then Jesus answered and said, "O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him here to Me." 18 And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour. ¹⁹ Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" ²⁰ So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. ²¹However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting." ²² Now while they were staying in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men, ²³ and they will kill Him, and the third day He will be raised up." And they were exceedingly sorrowful.
