Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone III — Let the heavens rejoice; let the earth be glad: for the Lord hath shewn strength with His arm; He hath trampled down death by death; He hath become the first-born of the dead; He hath delivered us from the depths of hell, and hath granted, unto the world, great mercy.

Troparion, Tone V — Lo, thy care for thy flock in its sojourn prefigured the supplications that thou ever offerest up for the whole world; thus we believe, having come to know thy love, O holy hierarch and wonderworker John; wholly hallowed by God through the ministry of the all-pure Mysteries, and, thyself, ever strengthened thereby, thou hast hastened to the suffering, O most gladsome healer; hasten, now, also to the aid of us that honour thee with all our heart.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone III — On this day, Thou didst rise from the tomb, O merciful One, leading us from the gates of death: on this day, Adam exulteth, as Eve rejoiceth; with the prophets, and patriarchs, they, unceasingly, praise the divine majesty of Thy power.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone III: Sing praises to our God, sing praises! / Sing praises to our King, sing praises! (*Resurrection*)

Verse: Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy!

Tpistle: (Romans 6:18-23) Brethren, having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. ¹⁹I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, and of lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness. ²⁰ For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. ²¹ What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. ²² But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life. ²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Alleluia Verses:

Gospel: (Matthew 8:5-13) At that time, when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him, ⁶ saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented." ⁷ And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him." ⁸ The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. ⁹ For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this *one*, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does *it*." ¹⁰ When Jesus heard *it*, He marveled, and said to those who followed, "Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel! ¹¹ And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. ¹² But the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." ¹³ Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, *so* let it be done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour.
