Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone V — Let us, the faithful, praise, and worship, the Word, co-eternal with the Father, and the Spirit, born, for our salvation, from the Virgin: for He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead, by His glorious resurrection.

Troparion, Tone VIII — Thou art most glorious, O Christ our God, Who hast established the holy fathers as lights upon the earth; through them, Thou hast guided us to the true faith: O greatly compassionate One, glory to Thee.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone VIII — The apostles' preaching, and the fathers' doctrines, have established one faith for the Church; adorned with the robe of truth, woven from heavenly theology, it defineth and glorifieth the great mystery of piety.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone V — Thou didst descend into hell, O my Saviour, shattering its gates, as almighty, resurrecting the dead, as Creator, and destroying the sting of death; Thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O lover of man; and we cry unto Thee: 'O Lord, save us'.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone V: Thou, O Lord, shalt protect us / and preserve us from this generation forever. (*Resurrection*)

Verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer any that is godly!

Tone IV: Blessed art Thou, O Lord God of our fathers, / and praised and glorified is Thy Name forever! (*Song of the Three Holy Children*)

Epistle: (Romans 12:6-14) Brethren, Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; ⁷ or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; ⁸ he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness. ⁹ Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good. ¹⁰ Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; ¹¹ not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; ¹² rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; ¹³ distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality. ¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse

Gospel: (Matthew 9:1-18) At that time, So He got into a boat, crossed over, and came to His own city. ² Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you." ³ And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes!" ⁴ But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? ⁵ For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise and walk'? ⁶ But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—then He said to the paralytic, "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." ⁷ And he arose and departed to his house. ⁸ Now when the multitudes saw it, they marveled and glorified God, who had given such power to men.

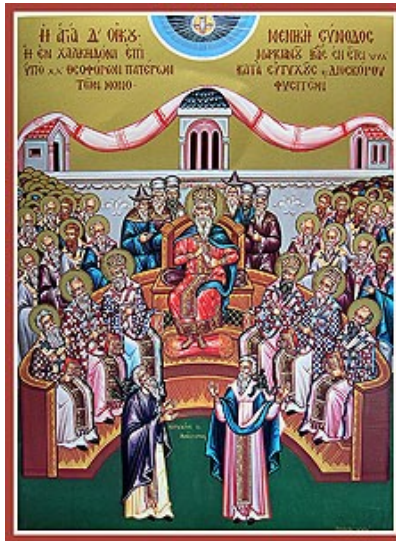
