Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VII — By Thy cross, Thou didst destroy death; to the thief, Thou didst open paradise: for the myrrhbearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy; and Thou didst command Thy disciples: O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

Troparion, Tone III — Holy apostles Silas and Silvanus, entreat the merciful God to grant our souls forgiveness of transgressions.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone IV — You were revealed to be branches of the vine of Christ, O wise ones, bearing clusters of virtues that pour out, on us, the wine of salvation; receiving it, we are filled with gladness; and we celebrate your most-honoured memory, apostles of the Lord, Silas and Silvanus; therefore, intercede that great mercy, and remission of sins, may be granted to us.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VII — The dominion of death can, no longer, hold men captive: for Christ descended, shattering, and destroying, its powers; hell is bound, while the prophets rejoice, and cry: 'The Saviour hath come to them in faith; enter, ye faithful, into the resurrection'.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone VII: The Lord shall give strength to His people. / The Lord shall bless His people with peace. *(Resurrection)*

Verse: Offer to the Lord, O you sons of God! Offer young rams to the Lord!

pistle: (1 Corinthians 1:10-18) Brethren, I plead with you, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. ¹¹ For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you. ¹² Now I say this, that each

of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas," or "I am of Christ." ¹³ Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? ¹⁴ I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, ¹⁵ lest anyone should say that I had baptized in my own name. ¹⁶ Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas. Besides, I do not know whether I baptized any other. ¹⁷ For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel, not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of no effect. ¹⁸ For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

 $G^{ ext{ospel:}}$ (Matthew 14:14-22) At that time, when Jesus went out He saw a $m{y}$ great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. ¹⁵ When it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, "This is a deserted place, and the hour is already late. Send the multitudes away, that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food." ¹⁶ But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat." ¹⁷ And they said to Him, "We have here only five loaves and two fish." ¹⁸ He said, "Bring them here to Me." ¹⁹ Then He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes. ²⁰So they all ate and were filled, and they took up twelve baskets full of the fragments that remained. ²¹Now those who had eaten were about five thousand men, besides women and children. ²² Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.


