HYMNS & READINGS

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone I — When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body, Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: "Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Thy Kingdom! Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who lovest mankind!"

Troparion of Ven. Ephraim the Syrian, Tone VIII — By a flood of tears thou didst make the desert fertile, and thy longing for God brought forth fruits in abundance. By the radiance of miracles thou didst illumine the whole universe. Our holy Father Ephraim, pray to Christ our God to save our souls!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone I — As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself. Human nature praises Thee as God, for death has vanished. Adam exults, O Master! Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries to Thee: "Thou art the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ!"

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion of Ven. Ephraim the Syrian, Tone II — Ever anticipating the hour of Judgment, thou didst lament bitterly, venerable Ephraim. Through thy deeds thou wast a teacher by example; Therefore, universal Father, thou dost rouse the slothful to repentance.

PROKEIMENON - Tone I: Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee! (*Resurrection*)

V. Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just!

EPISTLE: *(Colossians 3:4-11)* Brethren, When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. ⁵Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. ⁶Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, ⁷ in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them. ⁸But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. ⁹Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, ¹⁰ and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him, ¹¹ where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave nor free, but Christ is all and in all.

ALLELUIA VERSES: God gives vengeance unto me, and subdues people under me. • He magnifies the salvation of the King and deals mercifully with David, His anointed, and his seed forever.

GOSPEL: (Matthew 22:35-46) At that time, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, ³⁶ "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" ³⁷Jesus said to him, "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' ³⁸This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." ⁴¹While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, ⁴² saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They said to Him, "The Son of David." ⁴³He said to them, "How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying: ⁴⁴ "The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool" "? ⁴⁵If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?" ⁴⁶And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore.
