Troparion, Resurrection, Tone II — When <u>Thou</u> didst descend to death, O Life im<u>mor</u>tal,/ Thou didst slay hell with the splendor of Thy <u>God</u>head./ And <u>when</u> from the depths Thou didst <u>raise</u> the dead,/ all the powers of <u>heav</u>en cried out://"O Giver of life, Christ our <u>God</u>, <u>glory</u> to Thee!"

Troparion, St. Gregory Palamas, Tone VIII — O light of Orthodoxy, teacher of the Church, its confirmation,/ O ideal of monks and invincible champion of theologians,/ O wonderworking Gregory, glory of Thessalonica and preacher of grace,//always intercede before the Lord that our souls may be saved!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, St. Gregory Palamas, Tone VIII — Holy and divine instrument of wisdom,/ joyful trumpet of theology,/ together we sing your praises,/ O God-inspired Gregory./ Since you now stand_before the Original Mind,/ guide our minds to Him, O Father,/ so that we may sing to you:// "Rejoice, preacher of grace!"

Kontakion, Lenten Triodion, Tone IV — Now is the time for <u>action!</u>/ <u>Judg</u>ment is <u>at</u> the doors!/ So let us <u>rise</u> and fast,/ offering alms with tears of compunction and <u>crying:</u>/ "Our sins are more in number than the <u>sands</u> of the sea;/ but forgive us, O <u>Mas</u>ter of all,//so that we may receive the incorruptible crowns!"

PROKEIMENON – Tone V: Thou, O Lord, shalt protect us / and preserve us from this generation forever.

V. Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer any that is godly!

PROKEIMENON – Tone I: My mouth shall speak wisdom; / the meditation of my heart shall be understanding.

EPISTLE: (Hebrews 1:10-2:3) Brethren it is written - "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands. ¹¹ They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment; ¹² Like a cloak You will fold them up, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will not fail." ¹³ But to which of the angels has He ever said: "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"? ¹⁴ Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation? ² Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away. ² For if the word spoken through

angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, ³ how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him,

ALLELUIA VERSES: May the Lord hear thee in the day of trouble! May the name of the God of Jacob protect thee! • Save the King, O Lord, and hear us on the day we call! • The mouth of the righteous shall meditate wisdom, and his tongue shall speak of judgment.

GOSPEL: (Mark 2:1-12) At that time, Jesus entered Capernaum and it was heard that He was in the house. ² Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. ³Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four men. ⁴ And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you." ⁶ And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, 7"Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?" 8 But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, "Why do you reason about these things in your hearts? 9 Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise, take up your bed and walk'? 10 But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—He said to the paralytic, ¹¹ "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." ¹² Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"
